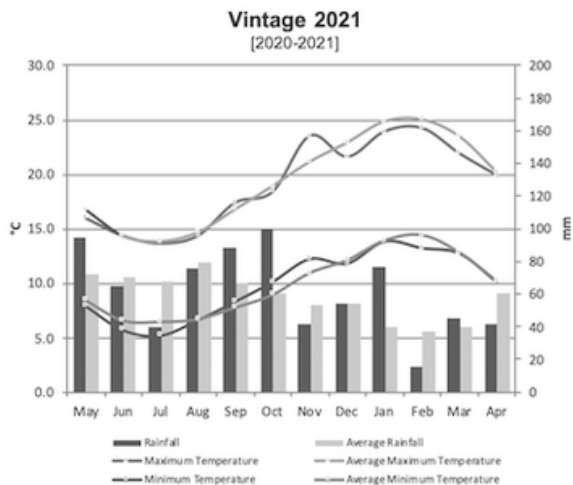


2021 VINTAGE

Moderate temperatures throughout a wet spring and flowering resulted in healthy canopies with slightly lower than average yields. Above average rainfall over the Summer due to La Niña was moderated by dry spells and moderate temperatures resulted in slower ripening. High levels of acidity were retained together with great concentration of flavour and fine detail.

Flowering – 23 Nov 2020 (av 22 Nov)

Veraison – 30 Jan 2021 (av 1 Feb)

Harvest – 29 Mar 2021 (av 27 Mar)

Hang time – 193 days (av 201 days)

Up v Down Difference – 14 days (avg 17 days)
